Shipper is required to be in Cambodia at the time of arrival of his / her shipment.

This letter can usually only be issued once the shipper actually starts on his new assignment. This letter takes 5 days to be issued. Only the US embassy can usually apply in advance. Still you may advise your client to double check with his mission if they could try and get it in advance exceptionally or if you let your destination agent know the name of the Mission he might check for you. But most of the time, this paperwork can be obtained only after actually starting at the

Your destination agent will need the Diplomatic ID card in order to clear the shipment. This takes approx. 1 month for the MOFA to issue it and can be obtained ONLY after the shipper actually starts his new position. The clearance will then take between 2-4 weeks. Demurrage and Storage charges will occur.

Current vaccination record and a "Certificate of health to accompany animals" from the Ministry of Agriculture from the country of origin.
