Duties of aprox 26% will apply</u></p> <p>Diplomats and foreign diplomatic personnel are exempt of duties when importing one vehicle. They are required to have a special authorization from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs</p>	<p><u>Cars import for returning citizens: The returning citizens will need to go personally to the Customs authority at the port of entry to request the import. Fumigation of wood packaging		<p>The Chilean Government adopted ISPM-15 (International standards for Phytosanitary Measures Publication 15) Guidelines for Regulating Wood Packaging Material in International Trade (aka NIFM-15) to standardise the treatment of wood packing materials used for the transport of goods.</p> <p>Shipments into or out of the country in wooden packaging, need to have a Seal, certifying that the shipment has received the required treatment (HT = Heated Treatment [a minimum wood core temperature of 56°C for a minimum of 30 minutes] or fumigation with Methyl Bromide (MT). The minimum temperature should not be less than 10°C and the minimum exposure time should not fall below 16 hours.</p> <p>The treatments established in the present regulation have the intent to reduce the introduction and/or the dissemination of quarantine plagues associated to the wood packing.</p> <p>The wood packing material must be marked in a visible location on each article, on at least two opposite sides</p>	<p>This regulation DOES NOT apply to wood packing materials manufactured of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Raw wood of 6 mm thickness or less</li> <li>• Processed wood produced by glue, heat and pressure, or a combination thereof</li> <li>• Plywood sheets &amp; agglomerated sawdust sheet</li> <li>• Oriented wooden fibre sheets</li> <li>• Sawdust &amp; Wooden fibre</li> </ul>
