<p><b>IMPORTANT NOTES</b></p>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Shipper must be imperatively present in Mauritius at the time of customs clearance.</li> <li>▪ Original passport imperative for customs clearance.</li> <li>▪ <del>Passport Memo to be obtained by the shipper at the Passport and Immigration Office of Port Louis before arrival of the shipment (returning citizen and expatriate)</del></li> <li>▪ Mauritian returning citizen must set up their Passport Memo at the Passport and Immigration Office of Port Louis before arrival of the shipment and at least 7 working days prior arrival of shipment at quay.</li> <li>▪ If goods belonging to a family of shipper (wife, husband, children) are loaded on shipment: original passports, residential permits, wedding and birth certificates are imperative for <b>duties &amp; VAT exemption</b> customs clearance.</li> <li>▪ Do not load on shipment: alcohol / pharmacy / <b>medicines / foods / detergents / tobacco / plants.</b></li> </ul>
