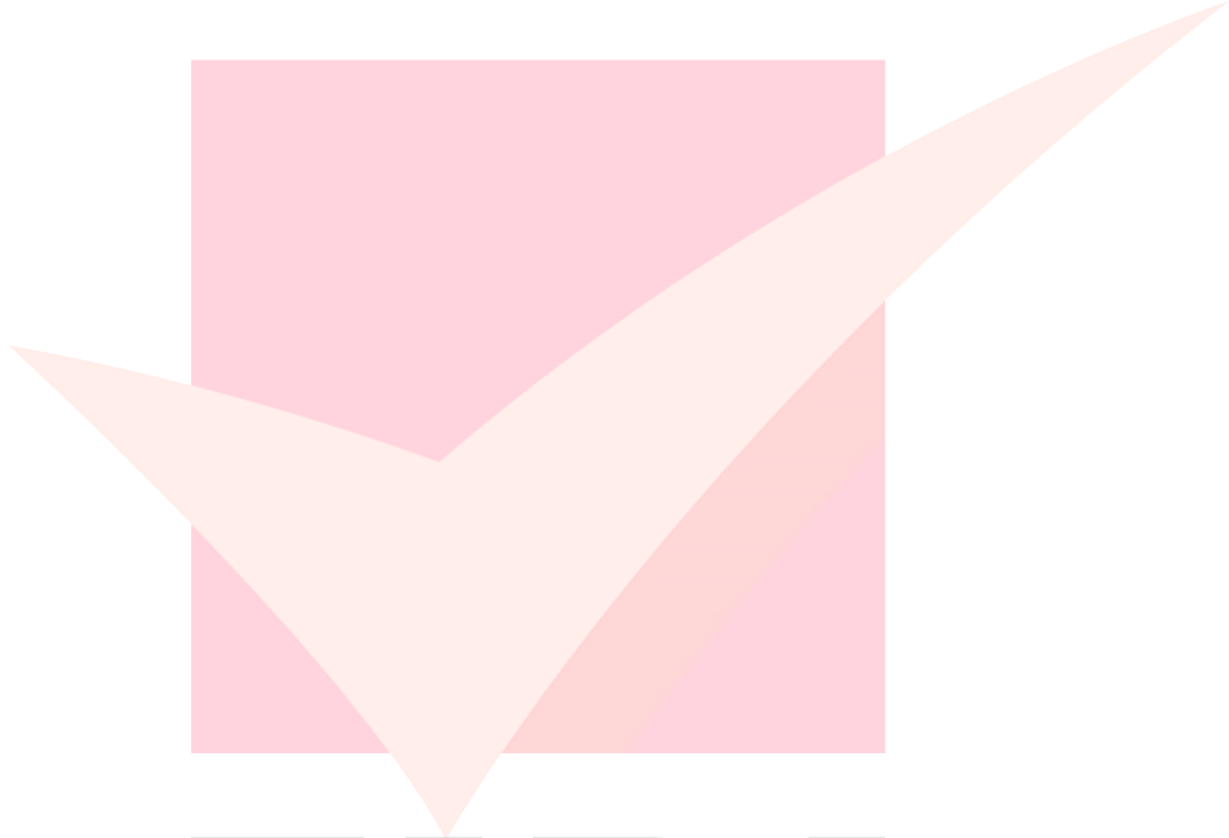

Only 20 DVD / CD are allowed. 	<p>Every in-bound / out-bound shipment is subject to issuance of customs declaration for each Harmonized system code (HS code). Cost of customs declarations will be advised during customs clearance process</p>		
<b>Prohibited items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Weapons of all kinds</li> <li>- Medicine / chemicals</li> <li>- Pornography</li> <li>- Narcotics</li> <li>- Toxic material</li> <li>- Radioactive material</li> <li>- Alcohol / food items</li> <li>- Live plants / seeds</li> <li>- Skins / animal furs</li> <li>- Feathers and items containing feathers</li> <li>- Drugs</li> <li>- Pets</li> <li>- Cleaning / washing materials</li> <li>- Items under pressure / flammables</li> <li>- Jewelry</li> <li>- Money / bank notes</li> <li>- Tobacco</li> </ul>

<b>Others</b>		<p>The consignee's organization mentioned on the waybill MUST be registered in Ukraine. If there is no detailed inventory list for any shipment then the customs officer is entitled to make intensive inspection and evaluate every item by himself. This process might take from 3 to 10 working days. This might lead to a substantial increase in total amount of customs fees and customs VAT to be paid by the consignee.</p>	



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
